Princes Risborough School Sports Partnership	£1400	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to a range of sports tournaments for pupils. • Increased enjoyment of sports by pupils. • Links with the community can be made through the variety of different competitions.
'Get Set 4 PE' planning resource	£660	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All teachers will have access to good quality planning. • Teacher will have video examples to help with teaching techniques to the children. • All teachers will be provided with a long term plan to ensure that progression in skills is seen across the school.
Sports equipment	£3000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils will have good quality equipment to work with. • Equipment purchased will support 'Get Set 4 PE' planning. • Different equipment will be purchased in order to expose the children to a variety of sports. • SEN and sensory equipment to help include all children in sport.
PE Enrichment Week	£1000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Book visitors and buy equipment needed for our PE enrichment week. • This will allow the children to get excited about sport and exercise and expose them to areas of sport and exercise they have not experienced before.
Skipping Workshop	£325	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children will have the opportunity to learn new skipping skills. • They will learn playground games which they can then play at break and lunchtimes to encourage the children to remain active.
Skipping equipment	£280	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 x playground sets of skipping ropes will be bought so that children can continue to use the skills they learn at the workshop to remain active during break and lunchtime, as well as during PE lessons.
Inter-house competitions	£300	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children will have the opportunity to participate in sport competitions at school. • Inter-house medals and rewards will be purchased to reward children for taking part in school sports competitions.
Premier Sports	£4201	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children receive PE lessons from trained PE coaches • All teachers have the opportunity to observe coaches deliver PE lessons as part of CPD.
Swimming lessons	£1000 (travel)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All children will be able to swim 25m by the time they leave year 6.

Transport booked for Sports competitions	<i>£2000</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minibuses/coaches booked for competitions which take place during school hours. • This will enable lots of children to participate in school sports competitions.
Sports Leaders and playground equipment	<i>£1000</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sports Leaders will be selected and trained. • Playground equipment will be bought so that the Sports Leaders can run activities at break and lunchtime • This will enable structured activities to take place for all children at break and lunch times to encourage them to stay active.
Work towards achieving Sports Mark Gold	<i>£2000</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implement 30 active minutes per day. • All children will be more active and alert at school. • Identify children for transition support and put interventions in place to allow them to access sporting opportunities. This will increase participation and enjoyment across the school. • Introduce new sports to the school so children have exposure to a number of different ways to stay active.
