What an exciting week! The children's excitement from our visit to Whipsnade Zoo spilled over into this week and they have been story telling in the small world jungle by taking on the role of zoo keepers to look after the animals. It has been wonderful to see the first-hand knowledge the children received during our educational visit now firmly placed in their learning. The children are certainly looking forward to their visit to Year 1 next week to meet their new teacher, Mis Grimaldi.

During T4W this week, we have been working on inventing new aspects of the <u>Dear</u> <u>Zoo</u> story in preparation to making it our own in the forthcoming week. This week, we focused on adjectives and recapped that these words help to describe and object, person or place. We were also introduced to a thesaurus to help us broaden our vocabulary and change the adjectives in the story. This week, we also began planning our poems about our favourite animals from the zoo. With support, we continued to use the thesaurus to help us make our writing more interesting.

During Maths this week, we completed our doubles learning and began focusing on halving and sharing. We learnt that when we halve objects, they make up two equal groups. We learnt to do this by helping our Greedy Monsters select their own party food and shared out the items equally by first offering it to one monster and then the other, until all our objects had been used up.

Our UW focus centred around nocturnal animals. The children chose which animal they would like to write about and worked in a small group with the adults to use books, film clips and their own current knowledge to write information about the animal. The children were introduced to using a word bank and are becoming increasingly independent in their writing skills.
